Informal Hearings will be conducted by appointment only

Protesting your 2023 Notice of Appraised Value

- 1) Complete the Written Form on the back of the notice and place it in the Mail or LCAD Drop Box.

Provide Accurate Contact information

- 2) Provide Supporting Documentation

State Your Opinion Of Value

Fee Based or Bank Appraisal

Estimates for Repair

Other Documentation relevant to the Protest

- 3) Submit by the Deadline Listed on the Notice

File Early

Protest submitted by Fax or Email will NOT be accepted per ARB policy.

After a protest has been filed, a hearing will be scheduled with the Appraisal Review Board. In some cases, a protest may be resolved without the need of a formal hearing. If this is possible, an appraiser may contact you.
